

PUBLIC SENTIMENT EXTENSION

(For use on LMA3163 Lloyd's Contingency Cancellation and Abandonment Policy - UK)

Notwithstanding subclause 1.1 of the Insuring Clause in the Contract of Insurance to which this Extension is attached, this Contract of Insurance is extended to indemnify the Insured for their Ascertained Net Loss should the Insured Event(s) be Cancelled, Abandoned, Postponed, Interrupted, Curtailed or Relocated as a result of a sudden, specific, identifiable incident happening at a specific time and place that results in the loss of life of two or more persons who are not Participants, provided that:

1. such incident is beyond the control of both the Insured and each and every Participant; and
2. the loss of life occurs:
 - 2.1. during the period of the Insured Event(s) or the 7-day period immediately prior to the start of the Insured Event(s); and
 - 2.2. within a radius of 100 miles from the Venue(s),

where it can be demonstrated to Underwriters' satisfaction that to proceed or continue with the Insured Event(s) would be against public sentiment and/or damaging to the reputation of the Insured.

All other terms, conditions and exclusions in the Contract of Insurance to which this Extension is attached remain unchanged.
