

PUBLIC SENTIMENT EXTENSION

(For use on LMA3164 Lloyd's Contingency Non-Appearance Policy - UK)

Notwithstanding subclause 1.1 of the Insuring Clause in the Contract of Insurance to which this Extension is attached, this Contract of Insurance is extended to indemnify the Insured for their Ascertained Net Loss should the Insured Event(s) be Cancelled, Abandoned, Postponed, Interrupted, Curtailed or Relocated as a result of a sudden, specific, identifiable incident happening at a specific time and place that results in the loss of life of two or more persons who are not Insured Persons or Participants, provided that:

1. such incident is beyond the control of the Insured, each and every Insured Person and each and every Participant; and
2. the loss of life occurs:
 - 2.1. during the period of the Insured Event(s) or the 7-day period immediately prior to the start of the Insured Event(s); and
 - 2.2. within a radius of 100 miles from the Venue(s),

where it can be demonstrated to Underwriters' satisfaction that to proceed or continue with the Insured Event(s) would be against public sentiment and/or damaging to the reputation of the Insured.

All other terms, conditions and exclusions in the Contract of Insurance to which this Extension is attached remain unchanged.
